Produced in selected areas of the distinguished Solar Terra Brum vineyards on Pico Island, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Solar Terra Brum's history dates back to 1796, when its first owner, Morgado José Francisco da Terra Brum, began to intensively cultivate his land for wine production.

VINIFICATION

Selective manual harvest in 15 kg baskets, gentle vertical pressing. This wine is fermented in cooled egg-shaped cement vats with indigenous yeasts at a controlled temperature. Matured on the lees for 12 months.

SERVING SUGGESTIONS

Excellent as an aperitif and delicious as complement of seafood and fish dishes

TASTING NOTES

Balance with marked salty minerality, dry, great texture, with a explosive aftertaste.
